

## **Driving and Parking Instructions for the FLARE Conference at the Mary Graydon Student Center**

The American University main campus only has one address: 4400 Massachusetts Ave NW, Washington, DC 20016. The event will take place on the **first floor of the Mary Graydon Student Center in room 128**. When you reach the first floor, head toward Panera, and room 128 will be just ahead.

American University offers flexible parking options for individuals who do not hold a parking permit. Pay-As-You-Go parking is available in hourly or daily increments (\$2/hour, or \$16/day) through pay stations located in select University facilities. Parking is available in the Katzen Arts Center garage, the School of International Service garage, and the east campus parking lot, which are highlighted in yellow on the map below.

**There are handicapped spaces available in each of the parking areas specified on the map on the next page.**

- The east campus parking lot is accessible from Nebraska Avenue NW. (Note, the only legal way to enter the lot is to take a right turn from Nebraska Ave into the entrance next to AU's Constitution Hall). The address for the parking lot is 3501 Nebraska Ave NW, Washington, DC 20016.
- The Katzen Arts Center is located on Massachusetts Avenue NW across from our main campus. When you arrive at the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue NW and Glover Gate (main entrance to the AU campus), turn right into the Katzen parking facility, and proceed to level P2.
- Another garage is underneath the School of International Service (SIS). This facility is located at the intersection of Nebraska and New Mexico Avenues NW. There is a traffic light at this intersection. (Note, you cannot turn left from Nebraska Ave. into the parking garage). The street address of the parking garage is 3498 Nebraska Ave NW, Washington, DC 20016.

If you plan to take an Uber or a Lyft to campus, enter 4400 Massachusetts Ave NW, Washington, DC 20016 as your destination. From the list of available drop-off points, select either Lydecker Way or the East Campus parking lot. Both locations are a short walk to the Mary Graydon Student Center.

If you plan to take public transportation, American University is also serviced by the DC Metro. The Tenleytown-AU stop is on the red line. You can take the free AU shuttle from the corner of Albemarle and 41st Streets NW, adjacent to the Wawa convenience store, to campus. Be sure to take the Blue Route Shuttle, which will stop in front of Kerwin Hall. The Mary Graydon Student Center is a short walk from the Kerwin Hall stop.

The D90 and C81 bus routes also have stops in front of Kerwin Hall on Nebraska Ave NW, which is a short walk to the Mary Graydon Student Center.
